

Jeffrey Krautkraemer "Pay it Forward" Scholarship

Goal: To strengthen community involvement and participation by the recipient

Criteria:

- An undergraduate or graduate student in Economics (with a demonstrated interest in Environmental issues).
- Student in need (broadly defined)
- Record of excellence in academic studies, with preference given to a candidate who has worked on an issue of environmental quality such as: preserving clean air, clean water, wildland and/or wildlife preservation; recycling, creating incentives for energy conservation, or alternative energy sources.
- Extra consideration will be given to a student who is first generation in college
- Candidates will write an essay about how the grant will further their commitment to work on behalf of environmental issues and have the recommendation of a professor
- Candidates will make a commitment to community service in the future on an issue of environmental or social justice, if he or she is not already involved in such community service. This commitment need not be specific at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Recipients will be chosen by SES Faculty or their designated representatives annually.
- Recipients will be chosen for their ability to balance excellent academic preparation with the full spirit and commitment to bettering the world and to be a force for healing in their community.
